

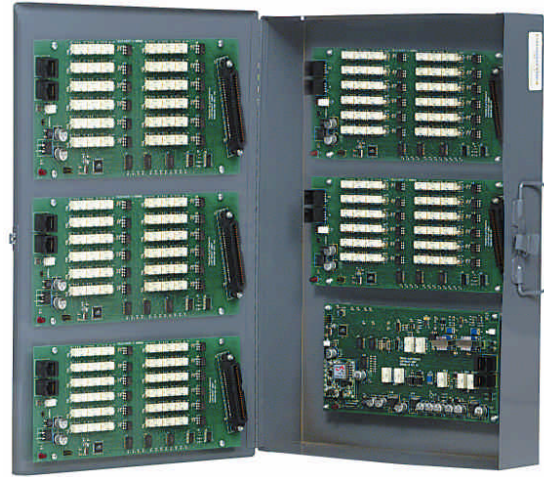
Mini 6000 Intercom

No Phone Charge Telephone Management System

Description:

The Trigon Mini 6000 telephone management system is an automated switch system for use with entry telephones - either programmable dialers or doorman stations. It turns any residents' telephone into a door intercom station. The system allows entry telephone-to-resident calls as well as resident to concierge calls. The system installs in the structures' telephone room, where it connects directly to each resident' telephone company blocks to assure normal telephone services. The system is comprised of easily serviceable circuit cards mounted in space-efficient racks and sturdy cabinets.

The Mini 6000 provides a wide level of features including custom programmability.



Features:

- ▲ Single Channel operation
- ▲ System is available in a call up/down model or a call up only model.
- ▲ Entrance call waiting can be blocked for uninterrupted modem or fax use.
- ▲ Can be used with existing dedicated telephone line entry equipment.
- ▲ Distributed programming capable with RS-485 floor to floor connections.
- ▲ Programmable via direct RS-232 computer link, or remotely via modem using Trigon's Tri-Com software.
- ▲ System is fully compatible with the Trigon RDIM module for use in Fiber to the Residence buildings.
- ▲ Non volatile memory...resumes normal operation if power is reset.
- ▲ Independent operation from outside phone assures "No Phone Charges" for all internal calls.

Applications:

- ▲ Provides "No Phone Charge" communication between residents and multiple entry location

Operation:

Operation of the Mini 6000 is nearly transparent to the user. Visitor calls are received on the residents telephone as is any other call. This allows any of the residents telephones to replace the intercom box traditionally located at the door with hard wired systems. The procedure employed by the resident to grant or deny visitor access is dependant on the entry system employed. Typical entry products, such as those by Trigon, will use the "0" key on their telephone to grant entry. They may press "7" or simply hang up to deny entry.

Since the Mini 6000 is processing the calls between the entrance and the resident, the telephone company is not involved and charges are not incurred. The system owner or management company is not billed for the call.

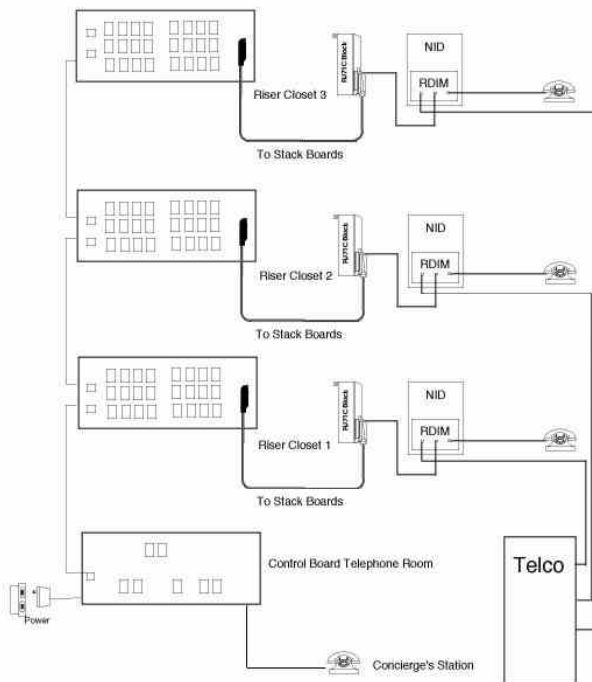
